- ❖ Safety

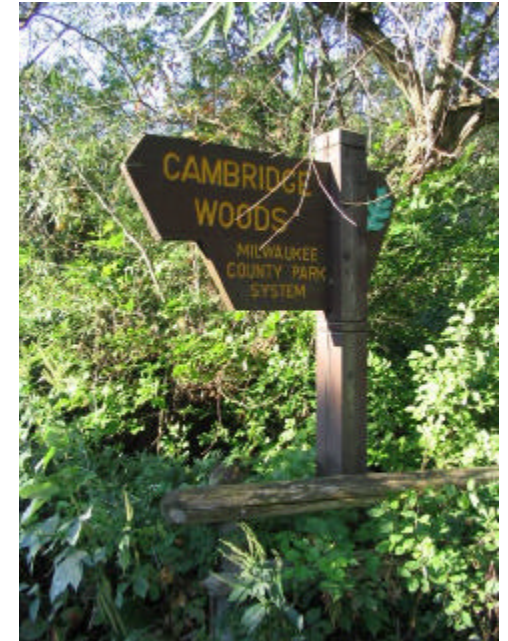
Public meetings are *usually* held every other month, featuring a combination of guest speakers and team updates. Meetings are in the evening and are *frequently* held at Riverside High School.

Cambridge Woods is a splendid Milwaukee Eastside neighborhood nestled between Riverside Park, the Milwaukee River with Oak Leaf Recreational Trail, and the Village of Shorewood's River Park. Hartford Avenue Elementary School, Riverside University High School, and the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee are all within a short walking distance from the neighborhood. The Urban Ecology Center with an eco-habitat playground is located in the Frederick Olmstead designed Riverside Park, and is easily accessible to Cambridge Woods residents and surrounding community.

The Oakland Avenue / University Square Business Improvement District offers a variety of retail businesses including a grocery store, pharmacy, copy center, barber shops and salons, and a mix of ethnic and American restaurants. The area is well-served by bus lines along Oakland Avenue and Locust Street, covering routes to all parts of the city.
